You will use your personal story and strengths to lead the change you want to make the most of in your world. You, along with your peers, families, and organizations will recognize your growth through gaining confidence, resiliency, relationship building, and positive change leadership. There is a commitment fee of INR 10000 to participate in the program which will be refunded upon certification. Program Overview

- Duration: Six weeks, starting on 19 Oct 2024.
- Weekly Time: 5 to 7 hours on online coursework and assignments.
- Group Work: Collaborate with 5-10 peers, using online chats and Saturday meetings.
- Sessions: Alternate between virtual and in-person (Intuit Facility-Bengaluru).
- Confidentiality: Maintain high confidentiality.
- Certification Project:
- Set project goals on a personal passion.
  - Guided by an Intuit mid to senior-level leader for 5-6 months.
  - Monthly progress reports in virtual meetings.
  - Completion: Get certified at an in-person celebration on Friday, 25 April 2025.

How to enroll?

- Complete Application:
  - Visit [leadingwithpride.com](https://leadingwithpride.com).
  - Describe what you want to change in the world and provide some personal details.
  - Include social media links and contact information.
- Deposit Commitment Fee:
  - Pay a fully refundable commitment fee of INR 10,000.
- Acceptance Notification:
  - You'll receive an email confirming your acceptance.
  - Return to the website to complete your online profile.
- Provide Assessor Information:
  - Give contact details for an assessor (your supervisor, friend, or associate).
  - The assessor will fill out surveys on your leadership skills at three points: start coursework completion, and pre-certification.
- Assessor Follow-Up:
  - Ensure your assessor completes the surveys on time.
- Check the website for more details on the assessor role.

How to participate?

- Weekly Coursework:
  - Complete 4 to 6 modules weekly before weekend sessions.
  - Dedicate 5 to 7 hours each week.
  - Engage with readings, videos, quizzes, and reflective exercises.
- Weekend Group Meetings: Saturday
  - Virtual sessions via Zoom: 9:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. (two-hour lunch break).
  - In-person sessions in Bengaluru: 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. (lunch provided).
  - Attend all six sessions fully prepared.
- Post-Coursework Project:
  - Pitch project idea to mentor.
  - Receive coaching from your mentor and support from LWP staff.
  - Monthly online group meetings to report progress.
  - Connect with past LWP participants for support.
- Mid-Project Networking:
  - Attend a high tea to network with mentors and peers.
- Project Completion and Certification:
  - Provide evidence of project completion and application of learned skills.
  - Attend the certification celebration.
